Family affairs.

Roderick Lloyd Joseph Golden is born on May 28th 1925 in Dundas, Ontario. He was not married. He is the son of Thomas Lloyd and Adelia Mary Golden (maiden name unknown) and lived with his parents in Brantford, Ontario 67 Grey Street. His father was a mechanic. He had 4 brothers and 1 sister. For more information about them **see Remarks**. At the age of fourteen he left St. Mary and St. Basil Separate School in Brantford to go to work. He reached Grade 8. At Silverwood Dairy in Brantford he worked as a butter maker. His hobbies were dancing, film and bowling. His favorite sports were swimming and hunting.

Militairy affairs.

He is enlisted on November 9th 1943 in Toronto, Ontario in the Royal Regiment of Canada. His training he got until December 9th 1943 in Toronto, until February 14th 1944 in Simcoe, Ontario and then to August 1st subsequently in Ipperwash/Woodstock, Ontario. The exact data are unknown. Then to Great Britain and on August 26th 1944 to France. He died of wounds sustained in combat on October 10th 1944 near Wommelgem Belgium.

He is temporarily buried at the Municipal Cemetery Candoncklaerhoef in Belgium 735946, Sheet 24&34.

On August 27th 1945 he is reburied at the Canadian War Cemetery in Bergen op Zoom, Plot 9, row D, grave 9.



Remarks.

- On his tombstone is written: "May he rest in peace".
- He received the 1939-45 Star, France-Germany Star, Canadian Volunteer Service Medal & CLASP and the War Medal.
- Total salary in 11 months active service are 186,85 \$ (Canadian), including last pay.
- He had as described 4 brothers and 1 sister, their names and data:
 - = Raymond Joseph , was 1 year older.
 - = **Eugene Francis,** was 3 years younger. They all lived at home with their parents.
 - = **Bernard Thomas**, was 8 years younger.
 - = **Peter Glenn**, was 11 years younger.
 - = **Yvonne Norma**, was 9 years younger.
